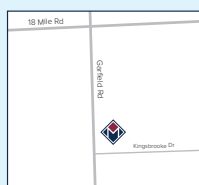

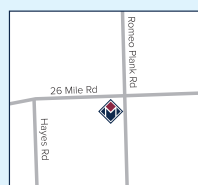

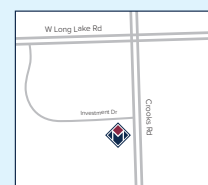

MSGCU's Preference Center is all about you.

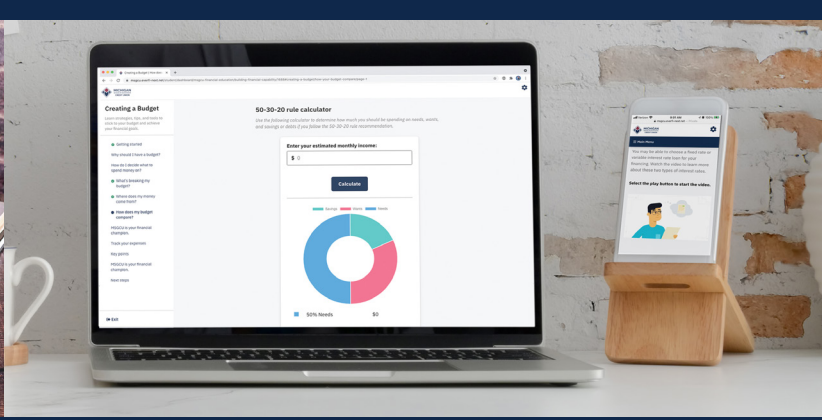

- Elimination of IRA Trustee to Trustee Transfer Fee of \$25
- Reduce Returned Deposited Item Fee from \$25 to \$10
- Elimination of Reg D Overlimit Fee of \$5

Help MSGCU give \$45,000 to local teachers in Classroom Cash Grants!

The applications are in, and now it's up to you and the community to determine this year's Classroom Cash Grant recipients. MSGCU will award \$45,000 in grants up to \$750 to local teachers. The grants fund deserving classroom projects that are otherwise not funded by school budgets like innovative ideas for student learning and activities.

Since its inception, the Classroom Cash Grants program has given more than half a million dollars in grants. Voting runs October 15-25.
